BRASS HAT unhurried early while placed off the inside, moved out a bit and advanced four wide through the second turn, challenged while still under a confident ride past the furlong marker, drew clear under a moderate hand ride to win ridden out. DIXIE MEISTER settled in the second flight toward the inside, moved out and came with the winner three wide and inside that one toward the front turning for home, proved to be no match for that foe late, game for place. ALUMNI HALL was put on the lead while off the inside past the wire the first time, set a modest pace while continuing off the rail, headed turning for home by WEST VIRGINIA, brushed with that same foe soon after, weakened, held sway for the show. WEST VIRGINIA pressured the leader, engaged that one turning for home, brushed, held a slight advantage past the furlong marker, faltered in the late going. MR. TRIESTE within striking distance in the three path, lacked the necessary response in the drive. M B SEA last away, raced well back in trailing, outside for the drive, little rally. SILVER AXE was never involved while racing off the inside. SANCTUARY'S OMOONI was finished after a half.
